## Additional Services

### ISBN/Barcode, Copyright, Library of Congress Number

In order to make your work more marketable, you might want to consider the following options:

**ISBN/Barcode (International Standard Book Number):** It is a 13-digit number that uniquely identifies books published internationally. The purpose of the ISBN is to establish and identify one title or edition of a title from one specific publisher and is unique to that edition, allowing for more efficient marketing of products by booksellers, libraries, universities, wholesalers and distributors.

If you want to sell your book through Schuler Books and Music or to other retailers, distributors or libraries, you will need an ISBN and barcode. We can assign your book an ISBN that will list Chapbook Press as the publisher. We will print your ISBN on your book's copyright page and place an ISBN barcode on the back cover of your book. We will also register your book with Books in Print.

#### **ISBN Cost: \$100**

You can apply for and purchase your own ISBN, listing you as the publisher, by going to [www.isbn.org](http://www.isbn.org). Then click on Order ISBNs, English Forms. You will then be able to apply for a single ISBN and barcode. It will cost \$125 for a single ISBN and \$25 for a barcode. This will take about two weeks. Once you receive your ISBN you will need to go to [www.bowkerlink.com](http://www.bowkerlink.com) to register your book title in Books in Print.

#### **Amazon Listing (\$50 one time fee)**

We will list your book on Amazon.com. The retail price of your book will have to be changed to cover all the fees that Amazon charges per transaction.

## Copyright

A copyright record documents the intellectual or creative ownership of a work and protects the work against misappropriation or other unauthorized use.

You can register your own copyright by going to the website [www.copyright.gov](http://www.copyright.gov).

Basic online registration costs \$35. Paper filing registration costs \$50.

Copyright becomes effective the day the Library of Congress receives a copy of your work (printed copy or electronic file). It might take four to five months for the Library of Congress to send your official certification of copyright to you through the mail. Electronic filing tends to be faster than paper filing. We will print your copyright information on your book's copyright page.

**Library of Congress Preassigned Control Number (PCN):** A Library of Congress preassigned control number is a unique identification number that the Library of Congress assigns to the catalog record created for each book in its cataloged collections. Librarians use it to locate a specific Library of Congress catalog record in the national databases and to order catalog cards from the Library of Congress or from commercial suppliers. If you want your book to be eligible for inclusion in libraries, you need a PCN.

You can go to the Library of Congress website at <http://pcn.loc.gov/> for instructions on how to get your own PCN. There is no charge for a PCN. But you are obligated to send a complimentary copy of the book for which a PCN will be provided immediately upon publication. The book becomes the property of the Library of Congress and is therefore non-returnable. It usually takes the Library of Congress two weeks to send an individual PCN. Once you receive your PCN, we will print it on your book's copyright page.
